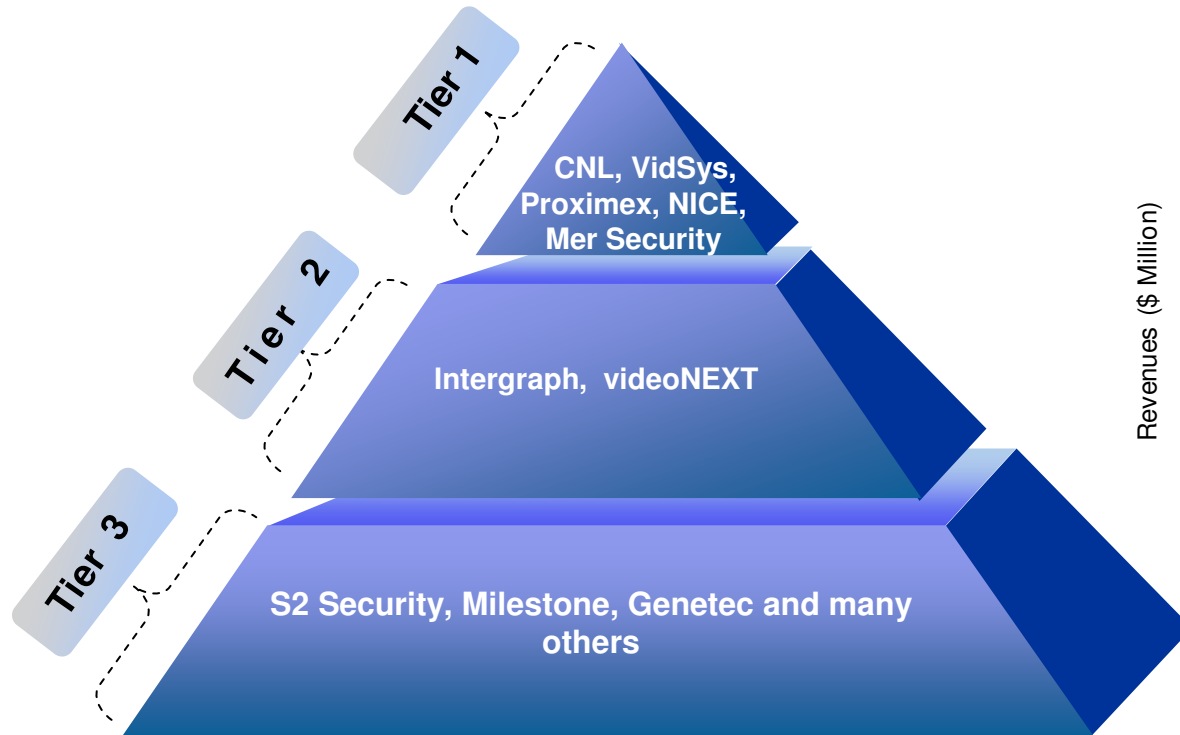

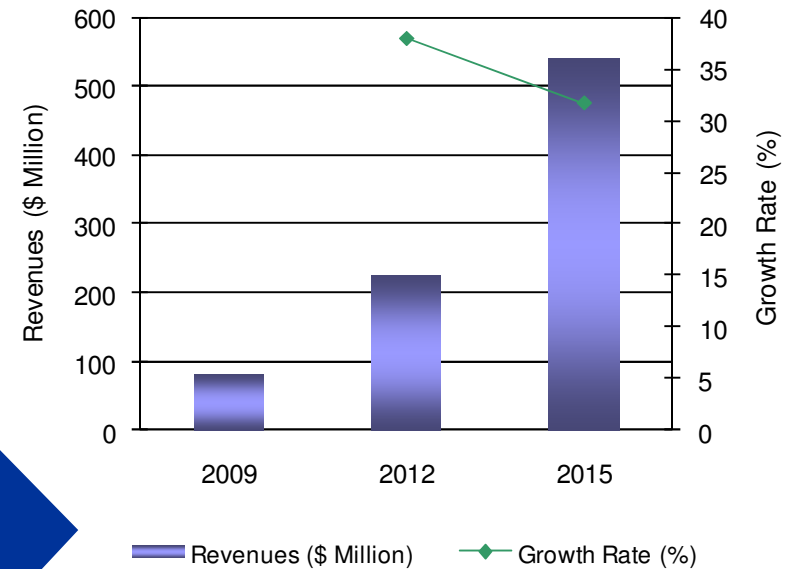


# Market at a Glance

PSIM Market: Revenue Forecasts (World), 2009, 2012 and 2015

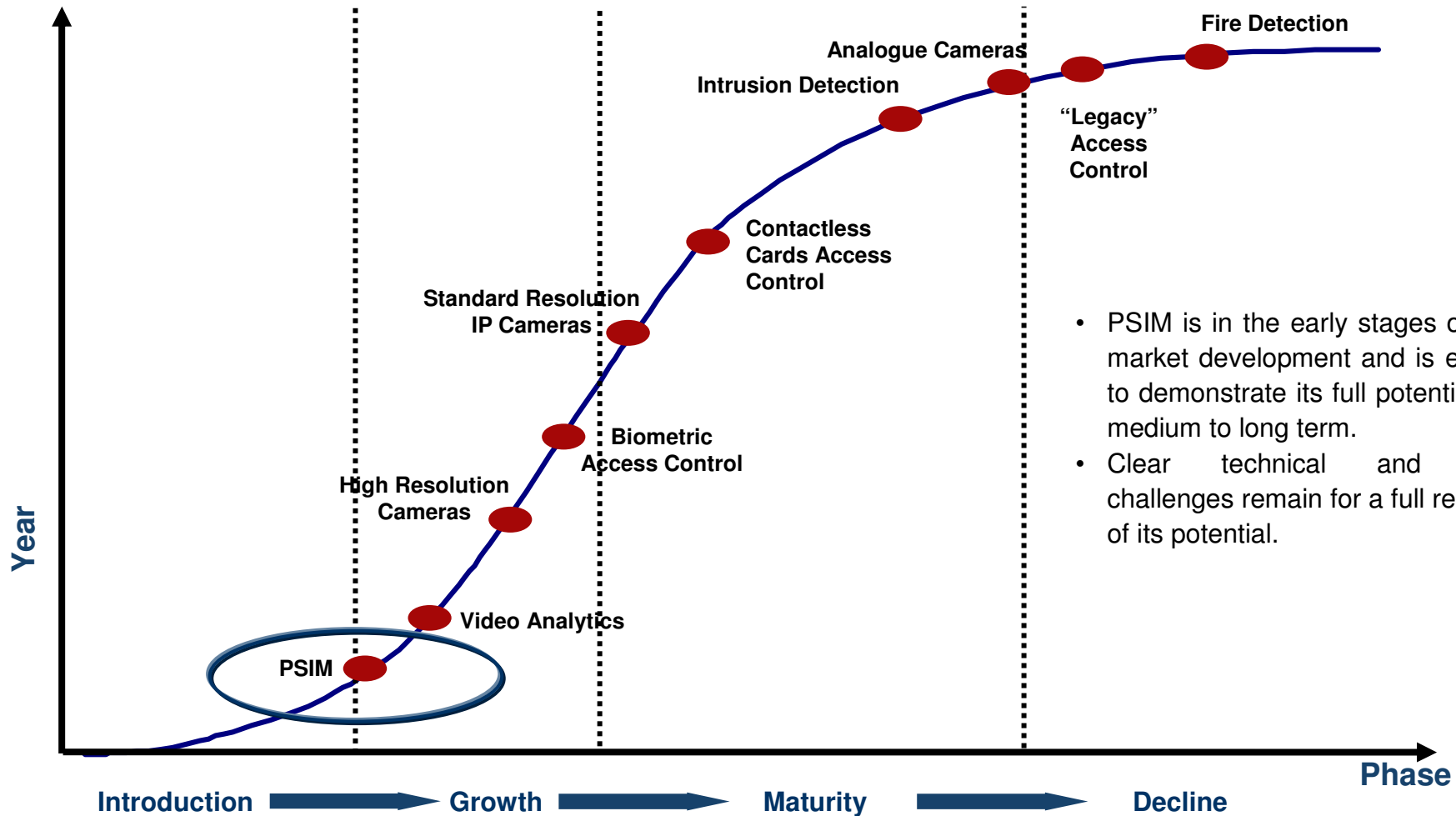
